# **PACKING LIST**

#### ATTIRE: WESTERN, WYOMING, ROCKY MOUNTAIN CASUAL

Casual outdoor/activewear is recommended for both day and night. During the day, dress in appropriate clothing that is best suited for the activities you plan on participating in. Wyoming weather can vary—anticipate cooler temperatures in early mornings and evenings and plan accordingly with layers and suitable outerwear. Synthetic, moisture wicking, and breathable materials are recommended for all apparel.

#### DRESS CODE FOR THE FARM AT BRUSH CREEK AFTER 4PM

We suggest Western Chic for women dining at The Cheyenne Club. This includes dresses, skirts, dress jeans or slacks. Cowboy boots are also acceptable. Gentlemen attending dinner at the Cheyenne Club should plan on wearing Ranch Style attire. This includes dress jeans or slacks, collared shirts, and cowboy boots. Formal jackets are also encouraged. Please note that non-collared shirts, polo shirts, worn jeans, tennis shoes or baseball caps are not allowed.

- · Bug repellent, sunscreen, lip balm

#### FISHING SPECIFIC RECOMMENDED PACKING LIST

- · Breathable waders
- · Boots (felt sole or rubber with studs)
- Rods (3 or 4 weight is perfect for French Creek, 5 or 6 weight is ideal for North Platte/ Encampment)
- · Floating fly lines, sink tip recommended for May/June
- · Quick dry pants
- Wet wading socks
- Polarized sunglasses

## UPLAND HUNTING SPECIFIC RECOMMENDED PACKING LIST

- Shotguns (12, 20, 28 gauge over/under for upland hunts; 12, 20 gauge semi-auto for waterfowl)
- Sturdy waterproof hunting boots (minimal or no insulation suggested)

- · Blaze orange clothing/vest for upland hunting
- · Vest for upland hunts
- · Waterproof gloves
- · Insulated hat, beanie

### BIG GAME SPECIFIC RECOMMENDED PACKING LIST

- Rifles (deer, antelope .270 or larger caliber, elk/ moose .300 caliber or larger, mountain lion .243 or similar)
- Sturdy waterproof hunting boots (minimal or no insulation suggested)
- Headlamp

- Camo/drab, waterproof, QUIET, outer layers for big game, waterfowl hunting
- · Binoculars, small day pack
- · Waterproof gloves
- · Insulated hat, beanie
